

## Executive Director's Report April 27, 2022

#### Administrative and Operational Issues/Initiatives

Remembering former SRIA Leader, Karl Winston Boyles, Jr. – Karl Winston Boyles, Jr., passed away on April 14. Mr. Boyles served on the SRIA Board from November 20, 1990-July 29, 2002. During those twelve years, he served four years as Chairman and seven years as Vice-Chairman. In memory of his years of service and leadership, the SRIA has made a memorial donation to the Pensacola Five Flags Rotary of which he was a founding member. The SRIA family extends our condolences to the family and friends of Mr. Boyles.

Remembering former SRIA employee Zachary "Zack" Butler — Zack Butler passed away this past Sunday, April 24. Mr. Butler joined the Santa Rosa Island Authority's Public Safety Department as a lifeguard in June 2005. In 2008, he began serving as the Program Coordinator for the Pensacola Beach Junior Lifeguard Program and continued to do so until his passing. Mr. Butler also taught adaptive physical education and physical education during his 15 years as an educator in Santa Rosa County. The SRIA family extends our condolences to the family and friends of Mr. Butler.

#### Staffing

After spending time evaluating the SRIA staffing needs and existing vacancies, it has become apparent that the Administrative Clerk vacancy within the Department of Development Services is the priority. To that regard, the position will be advertised beginning April 28 with the hope of having a new employee onboarded by June 1, 2022. This position was contemplated in the FY22 Budget, so funding is available. The position will bring much needed relief to the existing staff of two that review all plans and permit applications for Pensacola Beach.

#### 5G Update

SRIA staff recently learned that FP&L (through NextEra Energy) is modifying its position on colocation of 5G infrastructure on their poles. Previously, no co-locations were allowed, further limiting the options available to the SRIA and other local jurisdictions when reviewing 5G permit applications. While the specifics of the co-location program have yet to be finalized, staff seized the opportunity to convene meetings with FP&L and AT&T to discuss the permitting of any future 5G applications. Staff is encouraged that this will be a viable option for future permit applications.

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#### Blue Angels Pensacola Beach Airshow

Planning is well underway for the Blue Angels Pensacola Beach Airshow. The winter meeting was held on April 12 with all coordinating agencies participating. Additionally, learning from the November show on how to garner sponsorships, SRIA staff has successfully secured Step One Automotive as the sponsor for the Friday night reception. The Board will be kept apprised as planning continues.

#### **Economic Impact of Pensacola Beach**

<u>Tourist Development Tax Collections</u> (Attachment 1 – April 7, 2022, report as prepared by Pam Childers, Escambia County Clerk of Circuit Court and Comptroller)

The Tourist Development Tax (TDT) is a tax rate applied to transient rental transactions. In Escambia County the rate is 5% on the total payment received for the rental or lease of living quarters and accommodations (i.e. apartment, condominium, hotel/motel, mobile home or RV park, single-family home, etc.) that are rented for a period of six months or less.

The tax proceeds are statutorily limited in terms of use. In general, proceeds may be used for capital construction of tourist-related facilities, tourist promotion, and beach and shoreline maintenance; however, the authorized uses vary according to the particular levy. The Tourist Development Council (TDC) reviews proposals for the expenditure of funds to determine whether the expenditure complies with the tourist development plan of the ordinance and makes recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners for use of the funds.

#### **Beach Projects Update**

- Park West pavilion repairs, roof replacements, and replacement of platform and steps to the
   restroom Work is progressing as expected and should be completed within the next two weeks.
   Funding provided by TDT dollars.
- Beach Ball Water Tower Work is progressing as expected. The full structure has received the
  white paint and the beach ball colors and Pensacola Beach logo are being done now. Funding
  provided by TDT dollars.

- Pensacola Beach Sign The bid was opened on April 25. One bid was received, and it is being reviewed now to ensure it meets all of the requirements of the bid. The bid award is expected to go to the Board of County Commissioners at the May 19th meeting. The project timeline anticipates completion in November 2022.
- Quietwater Beach pavilions and restroom The Quietwater Beach restroom received interior renovations last year, and exterior painting was completed the week of April 18. Once the pavilion work is completed at Park West, the contractor will move to Quietwater Beach to begin work on those pavilions. Funding for the pavilions provided by TDT dollars.
- Guifside pavilion repairs and roof replacement Work is progressing as expected and should be completed in May. Funding provided by TDT dollars.
- Bike lane delineators on the bridge Project complete. Due to on-going maintenance and safety issues associated with the previously installed vertical delineators, it was determined that new approach was necessary. The identified solution was to install two rows of Reflective Pavement Markers (RPM's) to separate the vehicle lane from the bicycle lane. Installation of the RPM's, along with restriping, was completed this week.
- Eco Trail Signage Project complete. In 2021, SRIA staff with considerable volunteer assistance from Ms. Lila Cox, began work to expand the topics and species included throughout the Island's Eco Trail. In all, fourteen new unique panels\_were created. Installation\_of\_those panels was completed this week. The trail now consists of thirty-eight distinct panels in twenty-eight kiosks along the beach.

Tourist Development Tax (TDT) Collections

#### RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board accepts, for filing with the Board's Minutes, the Tourist Development Tax (TDT) Collections Data for the February 2022 returns received in the month of March 2022, as prepared by the Treasury Department of the Clerk and Comptroller's Office.

- Total collections received in March 2022 were \$943,959 compared to \$567,062 in March 2021. A four percent comparison of March 2022 to March 2021 is a 33% increase.
- Year-to-date collections for FY2022 is \$6,844,166 compared to \$4,212,108 for FY2021.

#### Five Percent Tourist Development Tax Collection Data By Geographic Area Escambia County, Florida Fiscal Year 2022 As of March 31, 2022

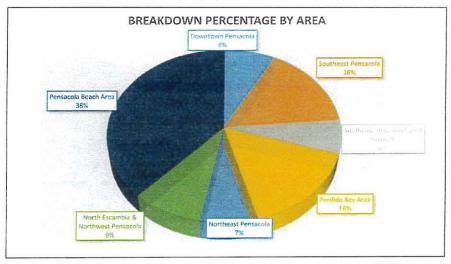
